The Music Festival season for 2015 is well underway across Canada!

- 1. As was mentioned in the Fall Newsletter (2014) our new fiscal year has changed to January 1 December 31. Membership dues for 2015 were to be paid by Feb. 15. This date is shown prominently on the Home page of our new Website. The Executive realizes that this change of procedure may have caught some of our members off guard, with the result being that some may have forgotten to pay them. For this year only, the Executive has decided to waive the late fee of \$10 until April 30, after which time the late fee (Section 7.01 of the Constitution) will be applied.
